What's nearshoring?

A Smarter Approach to Software Development

Nearshoring means outsourcing software projects to a nearby country - typically in the same time zone and with cultural proximity



Nearshoring vs. Offshoring

Nearshoring → aligned working hours, shared culture, short flights, smoother collaboration

Offshoring → often low cost, but higher risks: long flights, time zone barriers, cultural distance

Why should you consider nearshoring?

- **The pressure on Swiss SMEs is growing**

Talent Shortage	→ Senior engineers are scarce and expensive in Switzerland
Rising IT Costs	→ CHF +150/hour rates are hard to sustain for SMEs
Time-to-Market	→ Hiring takes months, while products need to launch faster
Focus	→ Internal teams can concentrate on core business



Nearshoring is not about “cheap outsourcing” -
it’s about smarter, faster, and safer scaling

Common pitfalls to avoid - Why nearshoring projects fail

Unclear Expectations

- Projects often derail when scope, deliverables, and KPIs aren't set upfront. Misalignment quickly leads to cost overruns and missed deadlines.



Cultural & Communication Gaps

- Even small cultural differences can cause misunderstandings. Without language skills and cultural fit, collaboration slows instead of accelerating.



Hidden Costs

- Travel expenses, extra management overhead, or unexpected contract terms can erode savings and frustrate SMEs who expected predictability.



Weak Governance

- Lack of transparency, poor reporting, or no accountability structures leave SMEs blind to progress and quality



Most failures are caused by poor setup, not by poor engineers

Success factors for SMEs

Define Objectives Early

- Clear scope, deliverables, timelines and KPIs prevent misunderstandings

Choose the Right Partner

- Look for proven SME experience, not just tech capacity

Communicate Transparently


- Weekly checkpoints, bilingual teams, shared tools

Balance Cost & Quality

- Don't chase the lowest rate - ensure efficiency and high compliance standards

Start Small, Scale Fast

- Test with a pilot project, then grow with confidence.



When done right, nearshoring becomes a long-term advantage - not a quick fix.

Step by step framework – your path to nearshoring success

Step 1 – Define Scope

- What problem are you solving? Align expectations early.

Step 2 – Select Partner

- Check SME track record, governance, and cultural fit.

Step 3 – Build Communication Model

- Agree on tools, language, and frequency of updates.

Step 4 – Secure Legal & Quality Safeguards

- Swiss/EU contracts, IP protection, clear SLAs.

Step 5 – Start with a Pilot

- Prove the setup on a small scale, then expand.
